5. Verbalize application of telemetry patches and monitoring of telemetry patients. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss telemetry room functions and location • Communicate with the telemetry room technician 		
6. Notify appropriate individuals with student and staff concerns <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unit manager • School of Nursing Liaison 		
7. Explain the patient safety bracelets and charms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purple, yellow, pink and red charms • Blood band
